Call Meeting to Order:

- 3. Ladder Truck in Service: Our new ladder truck is in service and working great.
- 4. Extrication Tools in Service: Our new tools are functioning, and the staff has been trained.
- Annexation of Rust Property: Chief Benn noted that he and BC Chief Brown have finalized the SEPA review and will present it next month to the board. It will then go to the Grays Harbor Boundary Board for review.
- Gurney Grant: BC Chief Brown stated that the 3 power load gurneys are being installed. After the meeting, a demonstration of the gurney will be available.
- 7. COVID-19: Chief Benn stated that the next board meeting may be held by Zoom. More information to follow on that as we get closer to the meeting day. Currently, we do not have information on the vaccine. It is provided through the state and then filtered to the counties.
