GOVERNANCE BOARD MEETING MINUTES 805 State Route 105 East, Westport, WA 98595 April 8, 2021-ZOOM Meeting: 5:00 PM

Call Meeting to Order:

The South Beach Regional Fire Authority Governance Board Meeting was called to order by Board Chairperson Alfred Schroeder representing Commissioner District Four at 5:00 PM. The meeting was held on a Zoom platform as the Governor has lifted restrictions for an in-person meeting. It was noted that the Zoom information had been posted on the SBRFA website for those who did not want to attend in person and posted at 170 West Spokane Street, Westport, WA. In attendance were the following Board Members: Alfred Schroeder representing Commissioner District 4, David McLellan representing Commissioner District Three, Tom Bearden representing Commissioner District Two, Sam Schlegel representing Commissioner District Five. The City of Westport representative Tom Aronson was absent. Chief Dennis Benn was present with Chief Daryl Brown absent. Governance Board Secretaries Diane McNett present. Teresa Hart, Board Secretary was absent. Present on the Zoom platform was Paul Barrow, EMT SBRFA.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Agenda Modifications:

Agenda modifications were the payroll of \$122,792.71 and the Vouchers 2021-128 through 2021-171 totaling. \$77,323.40. An executive session was added prior to adjournment for 20 minutes; the purpose to discuss possible litigation, no action to be taken.

a. Contract Committee-Chief Dennis Benn: Chief Benn stated that contracts have been sent.

Commissioner District Five Sam Schlegel: Sam Schlegel questioned Chief Benn if he had investigated the property at the old Pacific County dump. Chief Benn stated that there are some legal obligations with the tribe as the property appears to be contaminated. More information will follow regarding the availability of the property.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

ACTION ITEMS: The 2022 budget was presented by Chief Benn. Discussion followed with Sam Schlegel making a motion to approve the 2022 budget as presented. The amount is \$2,992,000.00. This includes the M&O levy amount of \$696,000. Motion seconded by Tom Bearden. Motion carried. Chief Benn will contact Brian Snure to prepare the resolutions for the ballot measure. A special board meeting will be scheduled to approve the resolutions so that they can be forwarded to the election board.

REVIEW SURPLUS POLICY: Chief Benn presented a surplus policy for the board's review. A motion was made by Dave McLellan to approve the policy as written. Motion seconded by Tom Bearden. Motion carried.

SET DATE FOR APPROVAL OF BUDGET RESOLUTION: This will be scheduled once the paperwork is received from Brian Snure.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Volunteer Recruitment Ocosta: Chief Benn stated we are getting close to gaining recruits from the Ocosta area. Sam Schlegel stated he thinks we should drill in each area.
- 2. Brush at North Cove Station: Chief Benn stated that he has met with the property owner who expressed interest in letting us cut the scotch broom, south of the North Cove Station.
- Hydrant at the Training Center: Discussed was how much it would cost to install a hydrant at the
 training center. Chief Benn stated he believes they are \$4,500 to approximately \$7,000. The possibility
 of also drilling a well was discussed. Chief will investigate the feasibility.
- 4. Grays Harbor Community Hospital has changed their name to Harbor Regional Health.

Board for Volunteer Fire Fighter meeting report: The Board for Volunteer Fire Fighter Fund meeting was held at 4:30 PM. No action was taken.
