Call Meeting to Order:

The South Beach Regional Fire Authority Governance Board Meeting was called to order by Board Chairperson Alfred Schroeder representing Commissioner District Four at 5:00 PM. The meeting was held on a Zoom platform as the Governor has lifted restrictions for an in-person meeting. Chief Benn stated it had not arrived yet.

CHIEF'S REPORT:

ACTION ITEMS:

Chief Benn stated we partnered with the Department of Health for a covid testing site. It has been well received in the community.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Volunteer Recruitment Ocosta: Chief Benn stated we now have 6 responders in the Ocosta area. This
 could be a boost for the rating once we have the paperwork completed for them.
- Hydrant at the Training Center: Discussed previously was purchasing a hydrant for our property at the Y.
 A motion was made by Tom Bearden to authorize Chief Benn to proceed with purchasing a hydrant at an approximately \$8,000 cost. Motion seconded by Sam Schlegel. Motion carried.
- Chief Benn distributed a proposed resolution regarding "financial reserve". The resolution was discussed in detail with no decision made. It was suggested that the resolution be reviewed at the June meeting.
- 4. Chief Benn stated he is preparing a timeline of our vehicle replacements to be reviewed next month.
- Chief Brown stated that we are involved in a regional grant. If approved the cost to us would be approximately 10% or \$30,000.
