Call Meeting to Order:

The South Beach Regional Fire Authority Governance Board Meeting was called to order by Board Chairperson Alfred Schroeder representing Commissioner District Four at 5:00 PM. CHIEF'S REPORT:

ACTION ITEMS:

- Commissioner Photos: Jaime Pryor, PIO will be taking pictures of the commissioners at the conclusion of the meeting.
- Hose Testing: Chief Benn stated he would like approval from the board for the expense of the hose testing: \$5,783.95. This amount is over his spending limit. A motion was made by Sam Schlegel to approve the expense of \$5,783.95 for hose testing. Motion seconded by Tom Bearden. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- Insurance Increase: Chief Benn stated that we have been contacted by our insurance company, stating that our insurance will increase 56% starting in January. This is approximately a \$150,000 increase which was not budgeted for. The staff have been working diligently on obtaining quotes from other carriers and searching for alternatives.
- 2. <u>Dave Bell's Last Day:</u> Dave's last day on the books will be the 24th of September. Paul Barrow has already been hired to fill the EMT position. The reason we hired Paul early is because A shift had only one person.
- 3. <u>Captain's Testing September 18th:</u> We will be performing Captains testing on September 18th, to fill one or two vacant positions. We will be using a third-party testing program.
- 4. Covid Booster: Possibly available in November.
- Flu Shots: South Beach Regional Fire Authority in cooperation with Nurse Janet will be hosting a Flu Shot Clinic on October 6th from 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM.
- 6. <u>Grays Harbor EMS Inter-local Agreement Up-date:</u> Grays Harbor EMS is attempting to acquire some grant funding. The Inter-local agreement plan is on hold for now but may be implemented later.

Brought to the board's discussion was Chief's 302 Vehicle and the recent pending repair of a new heater. The estimated cost was slightly under \$900. Based on this the Chief's are requesting the board consider the ability to bid on a replacement vehicle on Gov.Deals. Discussion followed with Tom Bearden making a motion to authorize the expenditure of up to \$20,000 for a replacement vehicle of Chief 302. This is due to the immediate need of a vehicle for emergency response of our BC Brown. Motion seconded by Dave McLellan. Motion carried.
